• Protect Library e-Resources against Copyright Infringement and Avoid Excessive Download

The Library subscribes to many electronic databases, e-journals, e-books and other electronic materials for our PolyU community. We are sure our users find these electronic resources very useful in supporting their study, teaching and research.

When using the Library e-resources, we should be mindful of the copyright and license restrictions and should observe the Copyright Warning:



Copyright Warning

Unfair use of copyright works or violation of license agreements may result in the termination of access to e-resources for the entire University community. Activities including, but not limited to, excessive/systematic downloading or access via robotic tools are strictly prohibited. Legal action will be taken by the copyright owner. The Library will suspend users' remote access to all e-resources who have committed excess download. [More information]
