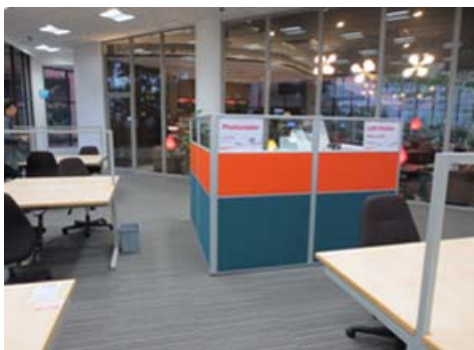
- **Power Extension Panels at Study Tables**



The Library fully understands users' need for power supply in the Library for supporting their use of notebook and other mobile devices. Before we can obtain the government funding support for the Library Extension and Revitalization Project for upgrading the entire Library building, we will try to provide power extension panels at some study tables, where possible, as an interim measure. 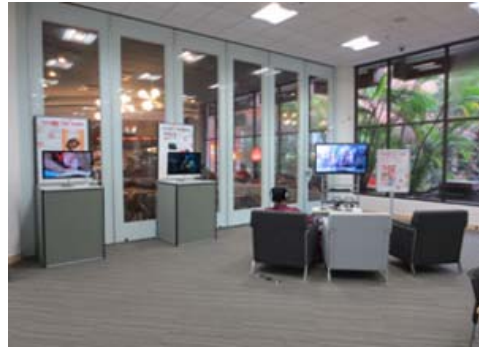
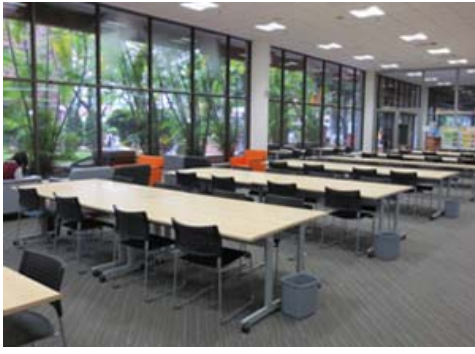
- **Printer Partition on P/F**

To avoid noise disturbances to nearby users, a partition has been installed at the printer and copier area on P/F.

Minor display is presented at a small corner of the area where users can relax and learn.
