The past year has been an exciting year as we continue to upgrade our services and facilities for you. A lot have taken place, and none more important than the merging of the former Serials and Acquisitions Sections together to form a **NEW "Acquisitions Section"**. With this new Section in place, we expect to be able to deliver even better services to you. Below are some key benefits:

Faster and more Convenient Acquisition Services through Consolidation

Acquisition of all library resources including books, journals, audio-visual materials and online resources which have been previously handled by different sections are now centralised and handled by a new section, the **Acquisitions Section (merged by the former Serials and Acquisitions Sections)**. The consolidation will improve our efficiency and productivity, allowing us to provide better and faster services to you. You now only have to approach one single section, rather than different sections depending on types of materials, for purchasing matters. There's no point doing research if no one knows about it. When you come to submit your work to journals, you'll want to identify the most appropriate and successful journals in your field. Publishing in high-quality peer-reviewed journals will enhance your reputation and help get your work cited by others. Also, you may wish to consider publishing your work in the **PolyU Institutional Repository (PolyU IR)** for open access to encourage intellectual exchanges with scholars and experts in your subject fields.

These strategies will enhance the discovery and scholarly impact of the PolyU work, increase the visibility and profile of PolyU and its many outstanding scholars and research groups. With planning and implementation work already begun and recruiting of materials beginning, the IR will be open for use in late 2008.

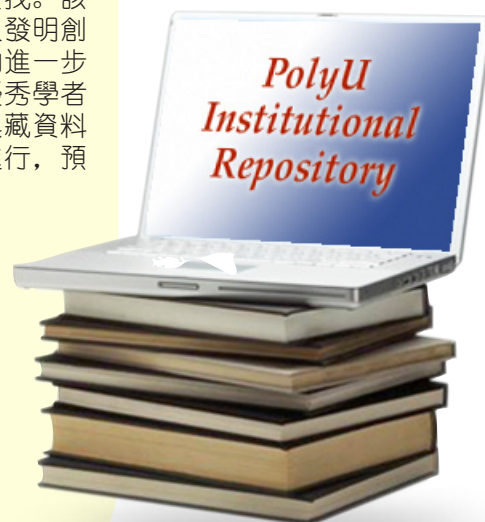

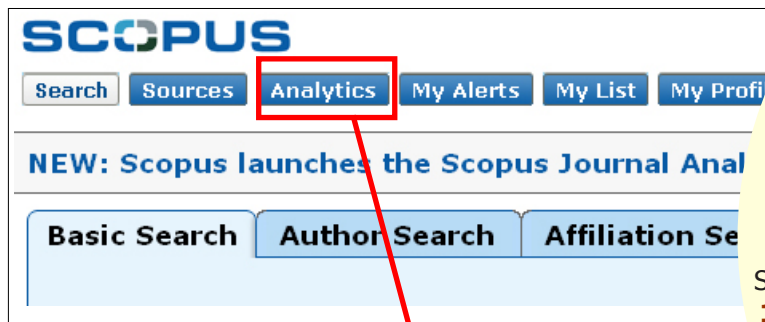

Publishing in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, which one?

如何選擇高水準同行評審的期刊來發表學術論文?

There are a number of resources we can use to identify high-quality peer-reviewed journals in different subject areas. In this issue, we will focus on the **Scopus Journal Analyzer**.



You can use the **Scopus Journal Analyzer** to compare the performance of journals, making it easy to see how journals are performing relative to each other.

It enables you to search for journals within a specific field, identify the most influential ones and find out who publishes them. This will help you decide **where to publish to get the best visibility for your work** and how to prioritize your submissions. What's Scopus?

Scopus is a multi-disciplinary, bibliographic database that indexes the content of over **15,000 peer-reviewed journals**, 33 million abstracts, 386 million scientific web pages, and 22 million patent records. The database also provides **references cited for articles** published after 1996.

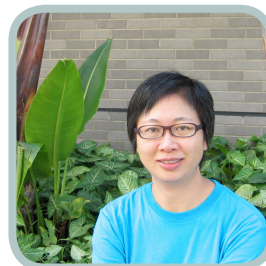

No Longer Among the Stacks

H C Li, our former Serials Librarian, has started his long leave in September prior to his retirement in December 2008. We bid him a fond farewell and thank him for his services to the University Library.

Successively employed as a librarian by the Hong Kong government, Hong Kong Polytechnic, University of Adelaide, Hong Kong Baptist College, Australian National University, University of Adelaide, and The Hong Kong Polytechnic University from 1971 till 2008, H C has also been a film critic since 1965. Besides publishing a number of articles on librarianship and numerous film reviews under his pen name Shu Ming, he is a joint editor of *Modern Chinese Poetry: An Anthology 1917-1949* (Hong Kong: HKU Press; CUHK Press, 1974), the co-editor of the Chinese-English bilingual programme catalogue *Ozu Yasujiro, 100th Anniversary* (Hong Kong:



Hong Kong Arts Development Council, 2003), and the author of two pioneering studies in Chinese on Japanese cinema: *Aspects of Japanese Cinema* (Taipei: Unitas, 1995), and *Japanese Cinema of the Heisei Era, 1989-2006* (Hong Kong: Joint, 2007). From 1989 to 1998, he published one article and three bibliographies in *Modern Chinese Literature*, a semi-annual edited by Howard Goldblatt. He also contributed a chapter to *The Cinema of Hong Kong: Arts, History, and Identity*, edited by Poshek Fu and David Desser (Cambridge: Cambridge University Press, 2000). His most recent book, co-authored with Prof William Tay of HKUST, is *Best Ten of Japanese Cinema* (Hong Kong: CUHK Comparative Literature & Culture Series, 2008).

After a 37-year career in managing books, HC has the following reflective thoughts on three interesting topics close to his heart:

Library

The library has evolved from a building full of books and journals to a virtual gateway to numerous global e-resources. A well designed, fully equipped, quiet and cosy, and user friendly library with an excellent collection is always a pleasure to visit, though the expertise of its knowledgeable librarians is the most valuable to the readers. The current library renovation process will undoubtedly enhance PolyU's study environment.

Learning

In the new digital age, the process of learning differs significantly from the past, mainly because technology has reshaped our thinking and more pervasively influenced our lives. The use of computers and internet surfing has facilitated text searching and fact finding, regrettably often at the expense of basic analytical skill and patient endeavouring. The urge to learn is more pressing now while the impartation of learning has some grounds for improvement. The PolyU Library will provide more flexible learning spaces on campus.

Literature

Reading stimulates the imagination, and great works of literature alert our critical thinking besides enhancing our emotional quotient. Masterpieces waiting to be enjoyed after retirement are: Murasaki Shikibu's *The Tale of Genji* in Royall Tyler's acclaimed translation (New York: Viking, 2001), Leo Tolstoy's *War and Peace* newly translated by Richard Pavear and Larissa Volokhonsky (New York: Knopf, 2007), Naguib Mahfouz's *Cairo Trilogy* (New York: Doubleday, 1990-1992), and Josef Skvorecky's *The Engineer of Human Souls* (London: Vintage, 1984). These four great works, superbly translated from Japanese, Russian, Arabic, and Czech respectively, add up to more than 4,000 pages with hundreds of characters living in 5 continents.

【告別書庫：退休雜憶】 李浩昌



記不起是那一年萌生的念頭，大概是在等待大學入學試放榜前那段迷惘的日子，想及自己的前途，有可能做教書匠，或者會在圖書館工作。結果真的教了兩年中學，然後任職圖書館長達三十七年。僱主依次為香港政府、香港理工學院、阿得雷德大學、香港浸會學院、澳洲國立大學，阿得雷德大學，以及香港理工大學。

三十六年來，我有幸在專上教育機構的圖書館工作，跟隨超過一年的大學圖書館長有：貝勵敦 (Barry Burton)、雷蒙德 (Ira Raymond)、溫賴特 (Eric Wainwright)、斯蒂爾 (Colin Steele)、喬特 (Ray Choate) 和歐書亭 (Steve O'Connor) 六人。他們都是澳大利亞公民，兩位出生於澳洲，三位來自英國，一位原是美國人。強將手下無弱兵，在他們的領導下，我和各大學圖書館的同事，多年以來，皆努力不懈地為讀者服務。



澳洲工作20載

1975年11月，我開始在南澳阿得雷德大學的巴史密斯圖書館上班。我主要負責中日文書刊的採購和編目，前後凡12年，於1984年休假一年回港工作，在1985年8月又改赴坎培拉的澳洲國立大學圖書館，專責日文書刊逾七年。我曾在英國和美國發表了兩篇工作經驗的總結，分別介紹東京神保町的古書業概況和香港的中文書籍供應商。

回巢理大13年

1996年1月，我重返香港理工大學圖書館工作。成立於1994年11月25日的理大，前身是香港理工學院，原創立於1972年8月1日，以前是紅磡香港工業專門學校。1972年我被政府外調往紅磡工專圖書館做主管，因此在1973年首位館長貝勵敦上任之前，我已在舊理工圖書館工作。

近十年理大圖書館的發展與時俱進，電子資源日有增加，一些罕見的舊期刊亦被收藏。外文方面有：百年的哲學學報 Kant-Studien (1897-2005)，作家訪問最詳盡深入的 Paris Review (1953-)，發表前衛創作和鼓吹反建制文化風氣的 Evergreen Review (第1-97期，1957-1973)，以及著名的藝術雜誌 Avant-Garde (第1-14期，1968-1971) 等數種。中文的更多逾三十種，其中最珍貴的四種是：圖文並茂的上海《中國畫報》三日刊 (第1-37期，1925)，香港日治時期創刊的《大眾周報》(第1-91期，1943-1944)，上海的附敵刊物《文友》半月刊 (第1-5卷，1943-1945)，以及替敵偽粉飾太平的上海月刊《風雨談》(第2-16期，1943-1945)。這些期刊價值甚高，在香港和中國皆不易找到，無疑是撰寫博士論文的重要參考資料。

電影文學不了情

我的正職是圖書館員，但工餘時間卻奉獻給電影與文學，並於1965年開始用筆名舒明發表影評。此後斷斷續續地寫，不經不覺已逾四十年。迄今出版了四本專書，約十篇學術論著，以及數百篇報刊文章。退休後打算多讀外國小說，先從日本紫式部的《源氏物語》開始。

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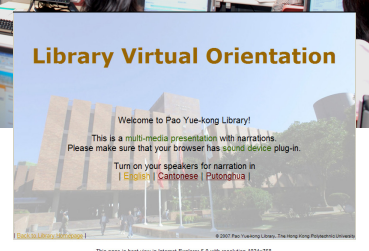

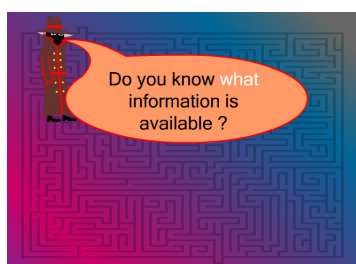

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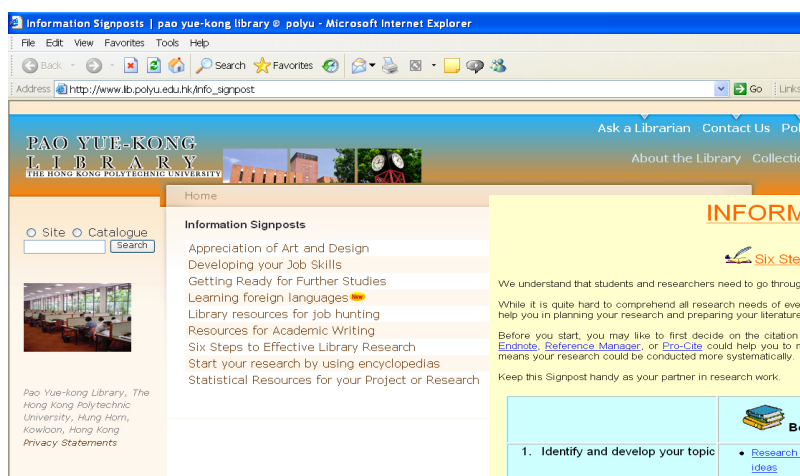

While it is quite hard to comprehend all research needs of every subject field, we have put together a handful of basic resources and relevant services to help you in planning your research and preparing your literature review etc.

Before you start, you may like to first decide on the citation style that you will use, e.g. [MLA](#), [APA](#) etc. Also, bibliographic managers, e.g. [RefWorks](#), [Endnote](#), [Reference Manager](#), or [Pro-Cite](#) could help you to manage your data effectively. An early understanding of what your chosen software can do means your research could be conducted more systematically.
